

## **Stone Mountain Man Arrested on Stalking Charges**

On November 6, 2013, Hall County officers were contacted by the Hall county School Board Office in reference to harassing emails. Chester Lamar Bagwell of 6654 James River Drive, Stone Mountain, Georgia, had sent several emails to the Hall County School Board Offices. The emails were harassing and threatening in nature. The case was assigned to a Hall County Investigator who called Mr. Bagwell and advised him to stop the emails to the school board. After being told this, Mr. Bagwell immediately contacted the offices again.

The investigator applied for and received a warrant for stalking against Mr. Bagwell. With assistance from authorities in DeKalb County, Mr. Bagwell was arrested on November 13, 2013 and booked into the Hall county Jail on one count of Stalking. Mr. Bagwell remains in the jail with a \$3000.00 bond.
