

## **County Agencies Work to Assist Stranded Residents**

On July 20, 2013 just after 3:00 PM, C. Rogers Road, in northern Hall County was washed out by localized flooding due to heavy rains, isolating approximately 100 families.

Hall County public safety agencies, including the Sheriff's Office, went to work immediately assisting those who were cut-off due to the road closure. The Sheriff's Office dive boat is being utilized to ferry residents from Clark's Bridge Park to a private boat dock at the end of C Rogers Road.
