

West Hall Middle School Burglary Arrest

A Gainesville man has been arrested in connection with an overnight burglary at West Hall Middle School.

On June 6, 2013 just after 10:00 PM, Sheriff's Deputies and Investigators responded to the school regarding a burglary alarm. Upon arrival they discovered a door that had been forced open, and during a search of the area a suspect was encountered attempting to remove a portable generator.

The suspect fled the area on foot, and a K9 team was called to the area to assist. Although the search was extensive, the K9 team was not able to locate the suspect immediately. However, Deputies remained in the area and at approximately 7:00 AM the suspect was located near the intersection of McEver Road and HF Reed Blvd.

Deputies arrested 29 year-old Adam Morgan Meeks, of Gainesville, without further incident and booked him into the Hall County Jail, where he was charged with Burglary 2nd degree and Obstruction of Officers (misdemeanor).

This case remains under investigation by the Hall County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Division.
