

Gainesville Couple Charged in Marijuana Grow Operation

On February 25, 2012, Deputies from the Hall County Sheriff's Office Warrants Division arrested 33 year-old Graig Theodore Medonat and 25 year-old Madeline Chelsey Stoddard a location in Forsyth County on Hall County arrest warrants that stemmed from a drug investigation in Gainesville.

The investigation began on February 16, 2012, when MANS and GTF Agents executed a search warrant at the couples' home, located at 632 Dixon Drive, in Gainesville.

During the course of the search, Agents located an indoor marijuana grow operation in the basement of the home consisting of fifty-one marijuana plants and over two pounds of processed marijuana.

The estimated street value of the marijuana seized was \$106,000.

Both suspects were arrested without incident and booked in at the Hall County Jail, charged with Manufacturing Marijuana, Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute, and Felony Possession of Marijuana.
