

## **Sheriff's Office Investigates Armed Robbery**

The Hall County Sheriff's Office is investigating an armed robbery that occurred overnight at Northwest Hall convenience store.

On February 16, 2012 at approximately 3:45 AM, Sheriff's Deputies and Investigators responded to the Kangaroo store in the 2600 block of Dawsonville Highway regarding a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival, Deputies discovered that a white male had approached the clerk inside the store, produced a handgun, and demanded money. The suspect then fled the store with an undisclosed amount of cash. He was last observed leaving the scene on East Sardis Road in a white truck.

The suspect is described as a white male in his thirties, approximately 5'11" tall, weighing 150 lbs., with red facial hair. He was reported to be wearing a dark colored hooded shirt and a dark colored skull cap.

No one was injured during the incident.
