

Gainesville Man Arrested on Drug and Weapons Charges

On February 15, 2012, Agents with the Gainesville-Hall County Multi-Agency Narcotics Squad and Deputies from the Hall County Sheriff's Office Uniformed Patrol Division arrested 66 year-old Jack Crane, of Hall County, during the course of a drug investigation.

Mr. Crane was arrested without incident after he sold a quantity of Alprazolam and Hydrocodone.

A search of his residence yielded an additional quantity of Hydrocodone and Alprazolam, as well as several firearms, one of which had an altered serial number.

Mr. Crane was booked in at the Hall County Jail, charged with Sale of Hydrocodone, Sale of Alprazolam, Possession of Hydrocodone with Intent to Distribute, Possession of Alprazolam with Intent to Distribute, Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony, and Possession of a Firearm with an Altered Identification Number.
