

Three Men Arrested for Drug Transaction

On January 30, 2012, Agents from the Gainesville-Hall County Multi-Agency Narcotics Squad and Hall County Sheriff's Office Uniformed Patrol Division arrested three individuals during the course of a drug investigation.

All three men were arrested without incident after they arrived at a pre-determined location to complete a drug transaction.

During the course of the investigation, Agents seized Oxycodone, Alprazolam, and marijuana.

All three men were booked in at the Hall County Jail, charged as follows:

Arrestee #1: Darrell James Pierce, 23, of Gainesville, Ga.

Charges: Possession of Oxycodone with the Intent to Distribute
Use of a Communications Device to Facilitate a Drug Transaction

Arrestee #2: Kelvin Deandre Dozier, 23, Of Buford, Ga.

Charges: Possession of Oxycodone with the Intent to Distribute
Possession of Marijuana (M)

Arrestee #3: Brandon O'Neal Brayboy, 24, Of Buford, Ga.

Charge: Possession of Alprazolam
