The Red Rabbit provides scheduled bus services throughout the City of Gainesville and parts of the City of Oakwood. Buses operate five days a week from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. One-way admission is \$1 for adults, \$0.50 for children up to age 18, students, seniors age 60+, and persons with disabilities.

Hall Area Transit is a public transportation system that has served the City of Gainesville and Hall County since 1983 and is jointly operated by the city and county. Its mission is to provide efficient, effective and affordable public transportation that will allow riders to access jobs, retail shops, recreational facilities, medical/dental offices, social service agencies, government offices, and other important community sites.
