

Hall County Increases Funding For Solid Waste System

The Hall County Board of Commissioners voted Thursday to increase the solid waste fee to support operational cost increases. The annual fee will go from \$50 to \$75, effective with the 2012 tax bill. The first increase since 1999, the additional funds will offset fuel and labor cost increases and needed equipment replacement.

Unincorporated Hall County residents pay the solid waste assessment fee on their property tax bills. The fee funds operation of the county's 12 compactor sites, hauling the material to the landfill and processing the material for proper disposal.

Hall County provides compactor sites as a service to unincorporated county residents, many of whom do not have access to private garbage haulers. The annual fee equates to \$6.25 per month, a low-cost option for residents for disposal of their household trash and recyclables.
