

Georgia's First Lady to Visit North Hall Technology and Community Center

Georgia's first lady Sandra Deal will visit the North Hall Community and Technology Center next week as part of her efforts toward improving literacy education in Georgia.

The first lady will be a part of a book donation ceremony at the North Hall library branch at 9 a.m. Tuesday.

Mrs. Deal began her "Read Across Georgia" initiative last year to support Gov. Nathan Deal's goal of increasing the number of children reading at grade level by the time they complete third grade. She has been visiting schools across the state, reading to students and emphasizing to teachers and parents the importance of literacy.

In addition to the books being donated at North Hall, books have also been donated in Mrs. Deal's honor to the Child Development Center at Georgia State University, as well as the library at Mary Lin Elementary School in Atlanta.
