

**Public Meeting on Cherokee Bluffs Park Set For April 15**

Hall County Parks and Leisure Services will hold a Public Information Meeting on the proposed Cherokee Bluffs Park on April 15. The meeting is scheduled to take place between 5:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Mulberry Creek Community Center.

Cherokee Bluffs Park is located off Blackjack Road in Flowery Branch near Sterling on the Lake subdivision. Plans for the more than 100 acre park include walking trails, an amphitheater and a disc golf course. Hall County purchased the bulk of the park's land in 2006 using SPLOST V funds.
