

Positive Rabies Alert In North Hall

This is to advise that there was recent contact between a raccoon and a dog in the Bills Circle area in north Hall County. The raccoon was shipped to the Georgia Public Health Lab- Virology Section in Decatur, where it tested positive for rabies. Hall County Animal Control was advised that the raccoon tested positive for the disease Thursday. This is the fourth confirmed rabies case of 2013 in Hall County.

Positive alert signs will be posted in the area where the rabid raccoon was located. If you live in this area or you see an animal acting abnormally in the area, contact Hall County Animal Services at 770-531-6830 or during non-working hours call Hall County Dispatch at 770-536-8812.

Animal owners are encouraged to vaccinate their domesticated pets for rabies. Vaccines are available at the Hall County Animal Shelter for \$10 Tuesday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., at 1688 Barber Road in Gainesville.
