

Nike Cup Soccer Tournament Canceled Due to Recent Heavy Rains

The Nike Cup soccer tournament, a portion of which was scheduled for this weekend at Allen Creek Soccer Complex, has been canceled.

According to the tournament's website, several days of constant and heavy rain have made for unsafe and unplayable conditions.

"We know that many of our participants are traveling long distances to attend Norcross Nike Cup, and we are very cognizant of the fact that everyone has prepared and planned for this weekend. Therefore, any decision to cancel Norcross Nike Cup is not an easy one, but we feel that given the conditions of the fields currently and the weather predictions for the weekend, we cannot, in all good conscience, provide the top notch experience that we strive for," said the statement on the tournament's website.

Allen Creek Soccer Complex was scheduled to host a portion of the Nike Cup soccer tournament, presented by Norcross Soccer Association, Dec. 7 - Dec. 8.

The tournament would have brought 112 soccer teams to Hall County for the two-day event. Teams from Florida, Tennessee, Texas, South Carolina and Alabama were expected to participate with 4,700 people projected to attend the tournament each day.
