

## **Property Tax Deadline Reminder**

November 18, 2013

Property tax is due by Sunday, Dec. 1. Our offices will be closed for Thanksgiving and the day after Thanksgiving (Nov. 28 and Nov. 29) in compliance with the Hall County Government holiday schedule.

In consideration of Dec. 1 falling on a weekend, the due date for payment will be extended to Monday, Dec. 2. Payments made in full that are U.S. postmarked or dropped off at the Hall County Government Center by 5 p.m. Monday, Dec. 2 will be honored as timely payment and will not incur any interest as required by state statute.

For the convenience of our residents, we offer the ability to pay property tax and tag renewals online. Residents can do so by visiting our website, [tax.hallcounty.org](http://tax.hallcounty.org). For those who wish to pay in person, we have an outside drop box located at the front door entrance to the building for after-hour payment. We also have a payment box located near our information table so that those who do not wish to wait may drop their payment there during regular business hours. Those who wish to pay by check, debit or credit are encouraged to use either of the drop boxes for both motor vehicle renewals and property tax payments or to use the online service. (A 2.59 percent bank fee will be added to all debit/credit payments).
