

Commissioner Gibbs Appointed To DCA Board

Hall County District 3 Commissioner Scott Gibbs has been appointed to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Board by Governor Nathan Deal. The Department of Community Affairs promotes and implements community and economic development, local government assistance and safe and affordable housing. The board is made up of 19 members, with 14 representing Georgia's congressional districts and five members serving at-large.
