Among the locations for the day's activities is the area of Atlanta Highway near Flat Creek. The Hall County Marshal's Office will also have several of its officers on hand to assist in the effort. Anyone interested in participating in that cleanup is asked to meet in the parking lot of La Flor DeJalisco at 8 a.m.

In addition to that location, clean ups will also be held in the areas of Oakwood City Park, Flowery Branch Train Depot, Fair Street Neighborhood Center, Lula Railroad Depot and the Braselton Community Room next to Braselton Town Hall.
