

## **Public Input Sought On Potential SPLOST VII Project Categories**

In conjunction with the three public input meetings which have been scheduled regarding SPLOST VII, the county will also be receiving input at the county website ([www.hallcounty.org](http://www.hallcounty.org)) beginning Wednesday, June 11th at 10:00 a.m.

A SPLOST is an optional 1 percent county sales tax used to fund capital outlay projects proposed by the county government and participating qualified municipal governments. SPLOST funds can be used for capital outlay projects, which are major projects of a permanent, long-lived nature, such as land and structures. They also include roads, streets, bridges, police cars, fire trucks, ambulances, garbage trucks and other major equipment. SPLOST funds cannot be used for maintenance and operation costs, however, a SPLOST is imposed for a specific period of time and for a specific purpose.
