

Tax Commissioner Reminds Taxpayers Of Mobile Home Tax Payments Due May 1

The Hall County Tax Commissioner's Office is reminding taxpayers that May 1 is the due date for mobile home tax payments. Upon payment of the property tax, owners of mobile homes are provided a decal to display on their mobile home in a location visible from the roadway.

Mobile homes that are temporarily located in the county and are owned by a business that is not located in the county should notify the Board of Tax Assessors of their presence to avoid being cited for failure to apply for the location permit.

As a reminder to citizens, the Hall County Tax Commissioner's Office has relocated from its former location in the Joint Administration Building in downtown Gainesville to the first floor of the Hall County Government Center, located at 2875 Browns Bridge Road, Gainesville. The office is open 8 a.m. –5 p.m.. For your convenience, secure drop boxes are located at the office (inside and outside). Additionally, online payment options for property tax are also available.
